






Learn the basics of an ASI Controls DDC System. Essential Training is a 4-day course that teaches you how to program our ASIC/1 and ASIC/3 controllers and engineer a project using our IntelliFront front end. For customers seeking IntelliFront certification, there is a certification lab exercise on day 5. Essential Training is a pre-requisite for Advanced Training classes.

Course Overview

The Essential Training course is your introduction to ASI Controls DDC systems. During this 4-day course (day 5 is optional) you will learn how to assemble a basic ASI system. You will learn about sequences in the pre-programmed ASIC/1 controllers and learn to configure simple ASIC/3 applications for solutions beyond the capabilities of our ASIC/1 line. There is an optional certification lab exercise on Friday for customers to become certified IntelliFront programmers.

Course Date/Location

This 4-day course (day 5 is optional) will begin at 8:30 AM on Monday, April 8, 2019 at the Holiday Inn Arlington-NE Rangers Ballpark. The street address is 1311 Wet N Wild Way, Arlington, TX 76011. Please return a completed enrollment form by Friday, March 15, 2019 if you are planning to attend.

Content

The Essential Training course costs \$2,345. After March 15, the cost will be \$2,645. There is an additional cost of \$700 for IntelliFront certification. Certified IntelliFront programmers also receive a yearly engineering tool license for the software.

All attendees receive the following:

- 4 days of training
- ASI Expert software
- ASIC/3-9540, ASIC/1-8100 and ASIC/1-6100 controllers
- Micro-SINC and USB device cable
- Carrying case
- 24 VAC transformer to power the controllers
- Optional IntelliFront certification (Day 5)
- All applicable documentation on USB drive



If more than one person from your company attends the same course, or if your company has already purchased a training kit, then each additional person may pay a course fee of \$1,045. After March 15, the cost will be \$1,345. There is an additional cost of \$700 for IntelliFront certification. The additional persons may use our hardware for the course, but would not keep the hardware after the course.

Candidate

An acceptable candidate for this program should have basic knowledge of HVAC and HVAC control systems. It is desirable that the candidate has some experience with designing, configuring, and/or installing DDC controls systems. The candidate should also be comfortable with the Microsoft Windows operating systems and be fluent in file management.

Each student needs a Windows 7 or newer PC with a free USB port and wired Ethernet connection. Many students also find it useful to bring an external mouse. Students must have administrative rights to their Windows account on their PC. Google Chrome is recommended for use with IntelliFront software.

Syllabus

ASI Controls has been teaching courses on our control system since our beginning. We believe that the best way to learn how to apply our products is through hands-on instruction led by an ASI trainer. In the Essential Training class, students create series of practical applications using ASI controllers. The course also contains lab time to further your understanding of system features. The general outline of our Essential Training course is listed below.

Day 1

- Programming ASIC/1 pre-programmed controllers
- BACnet networking
- Basic understanding of ASI Expert

Day 2

- ASIC/3-9540 configuration
- Introduction to objects
- Introduction to graphical configuration
- Sample AHU application

Day 3

- Introduction to IntelliFront
- Creating a new project
- Using the BACnet connector
- Building equipment graphics
- Creating histories and summaries
- Creating schedules

Day 4

- Creating alarms
- Building control logic
- Building floor plans and building elevations
- Creating users

Day 5 (optional)

• Project Application Lab for IntelliFront certification (+\$700)
